- Students from **partner universities**: **JPY 130,000** per person
- Students from **non-partner universities**: **JPY 150,000** per person

Round-trip flight tickets to and from Aomori, meals and transportation expenses during free time, visa application fees, insurance fees, and other personal expenses.
